

# Goose Chase

Fabric Requirements:

10 Fat Quarters

2.5 yards Background

Finished size: 65 x 79

1. Cut focus fabric Fat Quarters to 16 inch squares (white in pattern). Cut remaining pieces of fabric to 2.5 inches for step 7.
2. Cut background fabric into ten (10) 16 inch squares (blue in pattern).
3. Layer one background square with one focus fabric square. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the lighter fabric, as shown in Illustration 1. Pin together two layers.
4. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch on either side of the drawn line (Illustration 2).
5. Cut in half on drawn line. Iron units and cut to a uniform size.
6. Arrange as shown to make large flying geese. Repeat to create ten blocks.
7. Sew remaining 2.5 inch strips end to end to create border strips.
