Goose Chase

Fabric Requirements: 10 Fat Quarters 2.5 yards Background Finished size: 65 x 79

1. Cut focus fabric Fat Quarters to <u>16 inch squares</u> (white in pattern). Cut remaining pieces of fabric to 2.5 inches for step 7.

2. Cut background fabric into ten (10) <u>16 inch squares</u> (blue in pattern).

3. Layer one background square with one focus fabric square. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the lighter fabric, as shown in Illustration 1. Pin together two layers.

4. Sew ¼ inch on either side of the drawn line (Illustration 2).

5. Cut in half on drawn line. Iron units and cut to a uniform size.

6. Arrange as shown to make large flying geese. Repeat to create ten blocks.

7. Sew remaining 2.5 inch strips end to end to create border strips.
