

# 2022 PhxMQG Block Lotto

## April: May Flowers

Unfinished: 6½”

May is synonymous with flowers and baskets. So here is a very, very easy paper-pieced flower block. It is easy because there are only 7 pieces and only 2 are sewn on an angle and they are the last two you do. This is a great way to try paper piecing using minimal time and fabric.

### Fabrics to Cut:

- Flower center square: 1: 2¼” x 2¼” (piece 1) Use a bright fabric (solid or print)
- Bright Flower Side Petals/Leaves: 1: 2¾” x 3¾” (piece 4) Use a bright fabric (solid or print)
- 1: 3¾” x 6¾” (piece 5) Use a bright fabric (solid or print)
- Background: 1: 2¼” x 2¼” (piece 2) Use pastel, white or white-on-white fabric
- 1: 2¼” x 3¾” (piece 3) Use pastel, white or white-on-white fabric
- 2: 3½” x 7½” (pieces 6 and 7) Use pastel, white or white-on-white fabric
