

2022 PhxMQG Block Lotto

August: Scrappy Star

Unfinished: 18½" x 18½"

This delightful star block was suggested as a lotto block by Ana M. It's a quick and easy make. The directions let you choose between a 9-patch and an Ohio star variation for the center, but you can use any square block you wish, traditional or modern (one of Tula Pink's modern blocks?). Please use low-volume fabrics for the background and whatever you want for the remaining fabrics. You can use the same background fabric for all of the block or mix it up a little. Just have fun. And think of what you could do in all that negative space should you win! Remember solids and modern prints can make it look very modern.

If you have a slotted trimmer or whatever your favorite way for trimming HSTs, this is your block.



Cutting:

Block 1 (9-patch center)

5: 2½" x 2½" Low volume

4: 6½" x 6½" Low volume

8: 4½" x 4½" Low volume

8: 4½" x 4½" Scraps*

4: 2½" x 2½" Scraps*

Block 2 (Ohio star center)

5: 2½" x 2½" Low volume

4: 6½" x 6½" Low volume

8: 4½" x 4½" Low volume

2: 3½" x 3½" Low volume

8: 4½" x 4½" Scraps*

2: 3½" x 3½" Scraps*

*- scraps that have high contrast with your background look better
