September: Halloween Block

Unfinished: 12½" x 12½"

Here's a great chance to use (or use up) your Halloween novelty fabrics. You don't have to follow the color scheme, but the blocks might appear to be more cohesive if you use a black or black-background fabric for the four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and a "white" square for the very center. Won't this make a great lap quilt to decorate your house next month? If you want a more modern look, use solid fabrics. Remember, purple and acid green are also great Halloween colors! Grey is allowed too.

Cutting:

2: 4" x 4" squares of fabric A

2: 4" x 4" squares of fabric B (preferably in high contrast to fabric A for the 4 HSTs)

8: 3½" x 2½" rectangles in fabric C

4: 21/2" x 21/2" squares in fabric D

4: 21/2" x 51/2" rectangles in black fabric or fabric with a black background

1: 21/2" x 21/2" square in white fabric or fabric with a white background

You make 4 HSTs out of the 4" x 4" squares. Trim these HSTs to 3½" x 3½".

It's a chance to use your Slotted Trimmer if you have one!
