

Dear Gunta Block of the Month – August 2022 Row 8 + Outer Sections

Make Row 8 – Glue basting works great to stabilize your bias edges

- Sew Fabric N triangles to either side of a Fabric B 4-3/4" square. Trim off "dog ears" to true up the edges.
- Sew Fabric N triangles to the remaining two sides of the Fabric B square. Trim to measure 6-1/2" square.
- Make eight squares.







Sew Outer Sections for Rows 5-8

- Sew together:
 - a Fabric A 12-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangle.
 - a Fabric C 3-1/2" x 21-1/2" strip.
 - a Fabric A 15-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangle.
- Repeat to make a second unit.

Fabric C 3-1/2" x 21-1/2"

Fabric A
15-1/2" x 21-1/2"

Sew Together Rows 5-8 and Attach Sides
