

## FAST AND FUN FLOWER FUSING

Cindy and Claire will help you start your modern flower arrangement! We will show an improv approach, but all and any ideas are welcome. You can make up fantasy flowers or fussy cut realistic ones out of fabric. Flowers in the garden, or in a vase...or in the air!

The rules of this Challenge are simple:

- A finished bound quilt, three layers
- Minimum perimeter is 48" (ie: 12"X 12")
- Must be mostly fused fabric
- Must fit the theme of flowers
- Additional embellishments welcome (ie: beads, embroidery, buttons)

### **SUPPLY LIST:**

1. PRE-FUSED fabric scraps – pre-fuse your fabrics at home to save time. Use the paper backed fusible of your choice. Leave paper backing on.
2. Background fabric/s – suggest fat quarter but your quilt can be any size larger than 48" perimeter, so it is up to you  
OPTIONAL: Piece your background if you will need horizon line/table top  
OPTIONAL: Charm pack squares can work well as modern vase/s
3. Rotary cutter & Mat  
OPTIONAL: Rotary cutter with fancy blade or pinking shears
4. Scissors – Various sizes
5. Ironing pad/surface to work on
6. travel iron (can share)
7. Teflon or other protection sheet
8. Pencil
9. Pins, rulers, general sewing supplies
10. OPTIONAL: Inspirational photos

This challenge will be started during the meeting and then finished up at home. Completed quilts are due at the December 9<sup>th</sup> holiday party where they will be displayed.

All participants who display their quilt on December 9th will get a little gift and they will be entered in a random drawing for a \$50 gift card to the local quilt shop of their choice. AND REMEMBER IF YOU DON'T WANT TO KEEP IT, Diana will happily take it for Community Outreach!
