Disappearing 9 Patch Exchange at April 2024 meeting

Start with 5" charm squares

- 4 novelty prints for the corners. Can be all the same, or mix it up!
- 4 white squares
- 1 solid color, bright, place in center

Sew a nine patch with the novelty prints in the corners, and the bright solid print in the center. Fill in the rows with white fabric.

9 patch should be 14" square.

Slice the nine patch in half, horizontally AND vertically, to create four quadrants, 7" square. Spin two quadrants so the bright square is to the outside.

Sew the quadrants back together for the "disappearing nine patch" block.

Trim final block to 13 ¹/₂".



Note: if you are using directional fabric, position opposite corners "upside down" at the start so that the final block is all facing the same direction. I learned that the hard way!
