Presenting: Super Saturated Solids

“Nobody Puts Baby in the Corner”



Fabric:

Base Block:

6 ½” x 6 ½” square of BLACK fabric

Any high quality quilt shop black.

Better yet: *Cut 6 ½” x WOF – Width of fabric*

Subcut into 6 ½” squares

Now you can make more than one!

Accent Corners:

Scrap Pieces big enough to cover a large part of the corners

Cool and Warm Saturated Solids:

Cool Colors: Greens, blues and purples

Warm Colors: Reds, Oranges and Yellows.

****No pastels**

Step 1:

Place a COOL SOLID on one corner and have fun with the angle. Make sure that your piece goes beyond the corner of the black Square. When you are happy with the placement, place a pin and then choose a WARM SOLID and place this fabric ON THE OPPOSITE CORNER and place a pin.



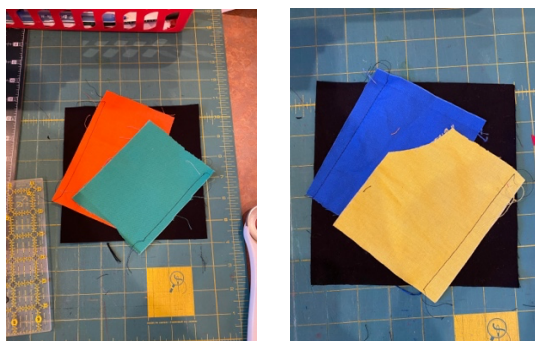
Step 2:

Flip it over the top of the black square, re-pin in place and



Step 3:

Sew it down!



Step 4:

Flip your corners pieces over and see that the original black corners are covered.



***If the scraps are a little shy and do not cover the corners, grab the seam ripper and shift the piece up to a better spot! It happens all the time.

Step 5:

Set the seam with a short press and trim the corners (which will be behind the bright solids you just sewed on.)



Step 6:

Press the block and, with a 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square, align the black corners with the corners of the square and trim the block!



But one just isn't enough!!!!

When the blocks are arranged for a quilt, the cools will be with cools and warms with warms.
