

This simple yet sweet block is offered as a local option in the Portland Modern Quilt Guilds, 2019 block of the month series. It uses simple quarter circle curves and is great for mixing up fabrics and using scraps from other projects. The pattern shared here makes a 6 inch raindrop, combined with 3 other raindrops it creates a finished 12 inch block.

The fabric requirements are:

Background: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

4 different purple fabrics at $\frac{1}{8}$ of a yard each

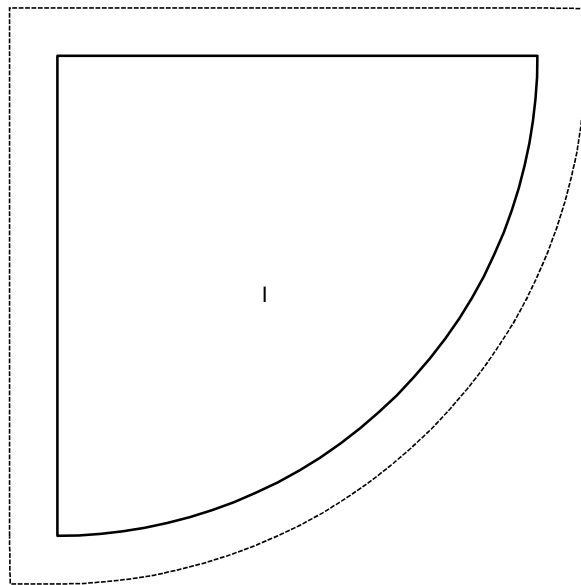
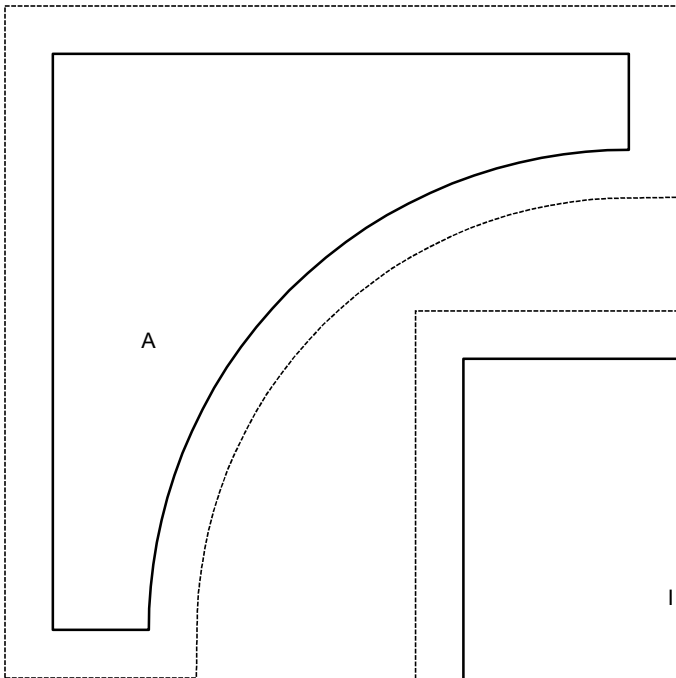
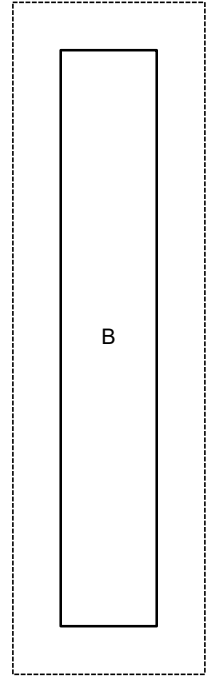
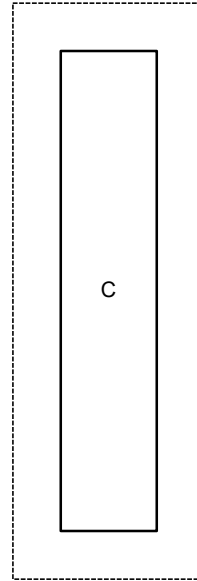
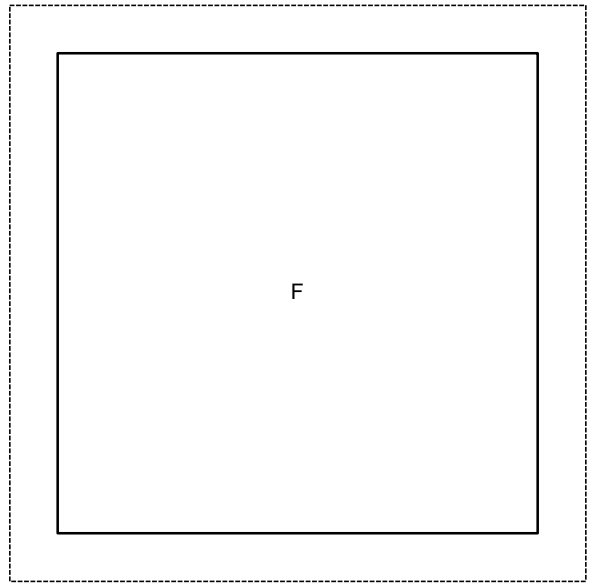
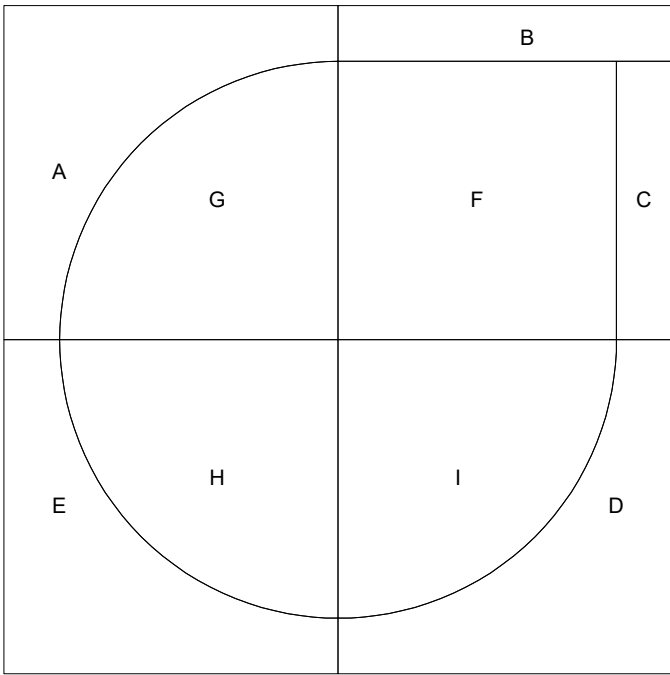
There are a few layout options and I hope you get to have fun with this one!

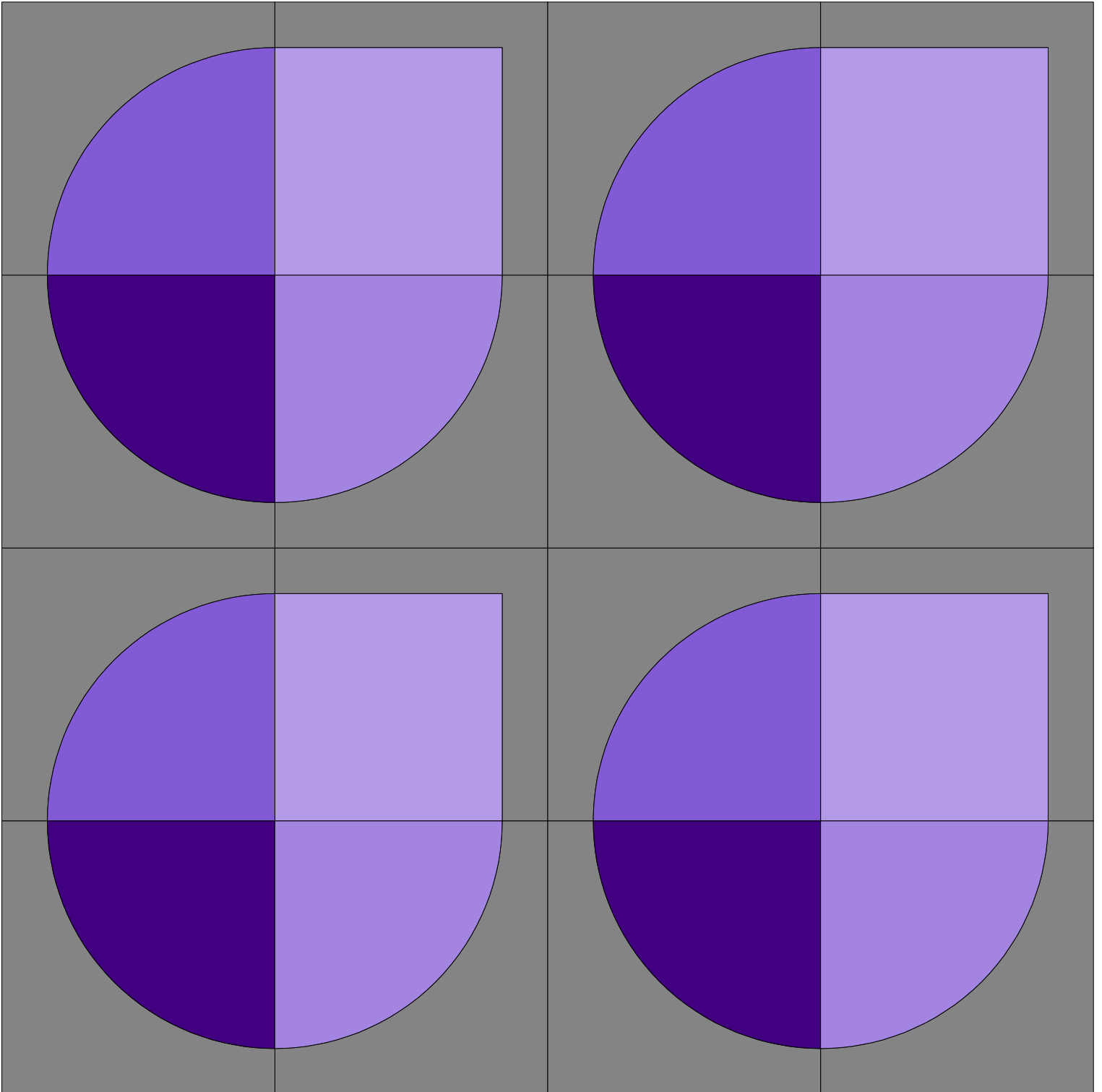
